## WARLPIRI LANGUAGE

## What is the Office of the Public Advocate (OPA)?

The Office of the Public Advocate (OPA) nguju maninja-wanu nyampu-kurra:

- Wiri maninjaku yangka rights wati yapa mental incapacity-kirli.
- Yalpi maninjaku yapa manmarrpa ngula-ka kapa-kapa jarri decision-making capacity, manu family, carers manu friend-wati.
- Manu yirraaka information jinta-kari organization wana.

OPA-irli ngulaju-ka information yirrani Education nyampu-kulu:

- Consent to Medical Treatment
- Advance Care Directives
- Guardianship and Administration
- Manu mental health

OPA Dispute Resolution Service-iji kalu yirrani Preliminary Assistance and Mediation kaji:

- Yapangku nguju mani Advance Care Directive (ACD).
- Wilji-wilji mani kalu-nyanyu consent manu medical treatment-iki.
- Manu disagreement decision-makers kulu.

Nyampu Public Advocate kalu jana mani yapa-kari South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (SACAT) irli nyampu Guardian of Last Resort-kaji:

- Yapa mental incapacity-kirli nyina
- Ngulaju lifestyle, manu accommodation, manu health decision nguju maninjaku.
- Ngulaju lawa jinta-kari yapaju ngarrin-jaku.

SACAT can direct OPA investigate yapa-kulangu circumstances kaji:

- SACAT kaji mani application
- Yapaju manmarrpa nguju maninjaku decision-making capacity, manu
- Yapangku wajampa ka-nyina purda-nyanyaku.

OPA can advocate for:

- Yangka rights-iki manu ngampurrpaku yangka mental incapacity-iki.
- Manu systemic change-iki.
- Legislative manu operational change-iki.

Nyampu Public Advocate ngulaju independent statutory officer, manu accountable nyampuku South Australian Parliament. The Office-alu ka separate mani South Australian Civil and Administration Tribunal (SACAT) -iki.
